PRESENTATION OF STALLION:

The Only Escape is a 16.3 hand, dark brown AQHA stallion born in 2002. In 2005, as a 3 yr old, he was named the Congress Hunter Under Saddle Futurity Champion and then in 2006 was named the AQHA World Show Junior Hunter Under Saddle World Champion. In 2005 he was Champion NSBA BCF and Redbud NSBA and was the AQHA and NSBA Year End High Point Champion Hunter Under Saddle Stallion.

FOALS: His first foal crop was born in 2007 and he has produced numerous Congress Champions and AQHA Reserve World Champions.

FOAL NOMINATIONS: NSBA SIF, the NSBA BCF Regular Division and the Premier Quarter Sires Program.

FOAL FUTURITY PROGRAMS AND DONATED BREEDINGS: ApHC SSA, Illinois QHA SSA, Iowa QHA SSA, Michigan QHA SSA, Pennsylvania QHA QIP, Premier Quarter Sires SSA, Southern Belle Futurity SSA, Tom Powers Futurity, WV QHA SSA.

GENETIC AND HEALTH TESTING: The Only Escape is tested AQHA 5 Panel Negative. He is homozygous, E/E, for the Black Gene and is not expected to produce chestnut/red-based offspring. He has been tested Negative for CEM and EVA and is annually vaccinated for EVA.
