This ICSI ADDENDUM agreement ("Agreement") is executed in addition to the DeGraff Stables, Inc. 2026 Stallion Breeding Contract and is entered into ("Effective Date") as identified by date and signature on Page 3 of the breeding contract...

Breeding Fee. See Pg 1 of 2026 Stallion Breeding Contract for 2026 Fee

Shipping Terms and Conditions. All frozen semen supplied remains the property of DeGraff Stables Inc and/or Chase Farms. Mare owner is entitled to receive and is responsible for all costs relating to the shipment of 1 frozen straw by DeGraff Stables Inc to the approved ICSI center...

Frozen semen will only be shipped to the address of an ICSI facility approved by Stallion Owner or its storage agent. Mare owner is responsible for any handling and shipping fees as they may apply. The parties agree that the obligations of performance by the shipping agent and by Stallion Owner shall be met when the frozen semen shipment is tendered to parcel delivery service for shipment and risk of loss transfers to Mare Owner.

Stallion Owner retains ownership rights to any unused doses/portions of straws of semen and reserves the right to reclaim those doses at no cost to Mare Owner. Unused doses of frozen semen may not be used in any other year or on any other uncontracted mare without advance approval in writing from Stallion Owner.

Multiple Embryos. Mare owner must notify DeGraff Stables of all embryos, should more than one embryo result from breeding to the Stallion during embryo harvesting. Mare Owner must pay an additional Breeding Fee (25% Discount) within ninety (90) days of a confirmed pregnancy in 2026...

Cryopreserved/Vitrified (frozen) embryos will be charged for the current year's breeding fee if not paid for and/or used in the same year as this contract. For all additional embryos implanted in 2027 through 2028 that result in a pregnancy, within 45 days of each additional pregnancy, mare owner shall pay breeding fees in effect at the time of each additional confirmed pregnancy.

No breeder's certificates will be issued until all breeding fees and/or penalties are paid in full.

Notifications. Mare owner must advise DeGraff Stables Inc the following as they are incurred:

- 1. The date of procedure and the total number of embryos recovered
2. The date for each and the total number of embryos transferred into recipient mares
3. Total number of embryos cryopreserved/vitrified (frozen)
4. The date when a cryopreserve/vitrified (frozen) embryo is transferred into a recipient mare
5. The date of ALL 30-day confirmed pregnancies

Stallion Breeding Report. It is the mare owner's responsibility to notify DeGraff Stables Inc by August 1st of any and all breeding dates for the donor mare and/or any recipient mare in order to be put on the Stallion Breeding Report. Mare owner's credit card will be charged immediately for all confirmed pregnancies as per the contract.

Failure to notify DeGraff Stables Inc of confirmed pregnancy may result in a fee penalty of \$1000.00 for each mare that was unreported. Penalties must be paid in full prior to issuing a breeders' certificate for any of the resulting foals.

Live Foal Guarantee/Rebreed Privileges. If the recipient mare absorbs/aborts a pregnancy or if the donor mare oocytes fail to conceive with the supplied ICSI frozen semen in 2026, DeGraff Stables and/or Chase Farms agree to offer re-breed privileges applicable ONLY during 2027 and will be subject to a rebreed fee of \$500.00 plus all applicable semen shipping or storage charges.

Rebreed/Live Foal Guarantee privileges shall only apply if DeGraff Stables Inc is notified of a rebreed/live foal guarantee event. If the mare does not return to an ICSI Center approved by DeGraff Stables Inc the following year for rebreed/live foal guarantee privileges, all fees paid shall be forfeited the right to a rebreed and live foal guarantee will be canceled, and DeGraff Stables Inc is released from all further obligations under this contract.

DeGraff Stables Inc and/or Chase Farms will be held harmless if a mare fails to settle for any reason.

**Certificates.** Upon notification of birth of a live foal and confirmation that all accounts are fully paid to stallion owner and/or agent and expenses and the performance of all other obligations of Mare Owner under this Agreement are paid in full. The Breeder's Certificates will be issued or released on line by Stallion Owner and mailed to Mare Owner for each of The Mares.

Breeder's Certificates for additional registries (other than AQHA, APHA or ApHC) may be available at a fee of \$100 each plus any costs to submit a breeding report for the organization.

**Substitutions.** If in the foaling year the mare designated in this contract dis or is unfit to breed and DeGraff Stables Inc is provided with a veterinarian's statement confirming these conditions, a substitute mare may be designated, with DeGraff Stables Inc prior written approval, at no additional charge. In all other cases, if an approved substitute mare is used by the Mare Owner, a \$250 mare substitution fee will be charged. If DeGraff Stables Inc is not notified and an unapproved mare is used the Mare Owner will be subject to a \$1,000 mare substitution fee.

**The LFG will become void** if the following conditions are not met: a. Mare Owner must forward a certification signed by the breeding vet that Mare or Recipient Mare did not settle and is not in foal by the end of breeding season; or, Mare Owner must notify Stallion Owner within forty-eight (48) hours of foaling or aborting that the mare did not produce a live foal; and within fourteen (14) days after Mare Owner's notice to Stallion Owner, the Mare Owner certifies to Stallion Owner that the birth was properly attended, and also provides proof of proper administration of rhinopneumonitis vaccine in the 5th ,7th , and 9th months of gestation, and also produces a statement from Mare Owner's licensed veterinarian stating details explaining the failure of the mare to produce a live foal. Unless approved by Stallion Owner in writing, the LFG shall be void and Stallion Owner will be released from liability if Mare is sold prior to foaling. Rebreed fee, semen fee and shipping fees apply to approved rebreed

**WARRANTY.** NO WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, SHALL ACCOMPANY A BREEDING COVERED BY THIS AGREEMENT. NO GUARANTEE OF DELIVERY OF SHIPPED FROZEN SEMEN WITHIN A CERTAIN TIME PERIOD OR GUARANTEE THAT SHIPPED FROZEN SEMEN WILL SAFELY REACH THE INSEMINATION POINT OR WILL BE THAWED WITHOUT LOSING SOME OF ITS INTEGRITY, QUALITY OR CHARACTERISTICS WILL BE GIVEN.
